

**TOWN OF KINISTINO  
BYLAW NO. 5/00**

A BYLAW TO PREVENT PERSONS FROM LOITERING IN OR ABOUT PUBLIC PLACES IN THE TOWN OF KINISTINO.

THE COUNCIL of the Town of Kinistino, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. THIS BYLAW shall be known as “THE LOITERING BYLAW”
2. LOITERING for purposes of this bylaw shall mean “Hanging Around” and shall include inter alia remaining in or about or near the vicinity of a public place without any apparent purpose or reason.
3. PUBLIC PLACE for the purpose of this bylaw shall mean:
  - (a) a highway, road, street, sidewalk, lane or other thoroughfare: or
  - (b) parking lot: or
  - (c) a place or building to which the public has or is permitted to have access; or
  - (d) a park or playground or other place of public resort or amusement: or
  - (e) any unoccupied land or building; or
  - (f) in relation to a person who enters occupied land or an occupied building without the consent of the occupant, the land or building so entered: or
  - (g) no person or persons shall stand in groups or sit or lounge on a public street in front of a licensed premises, restaurant, poolroom, boarding house, hotel or place of public accommodation or place of public entertainment so as to cause any obstruction to the free use of the street, or by any manner cause any obstruction to the free egress and use of any doorways abutting on the street, or on the step of or approach to any premises or dwelling open to a street whereby the public are subjected to disturbance or annoyance.
  - (h) any occupied land or building; or
  - (i) a conveyance while it is at, in, or on any place, building, thoroughfare or land that by virtue of sub-clauses (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (g) and (h) is a public place.
4. Every one who, without lawful excuse, the proof of which lies upon him, loiters in or about or near the vicinity of a public place is guilty of any offence punishable on summary conviction to the penalty specified within this bylaw.

5. Penalties for violation of this bylaw are as follows:

Minimum \$ 50.00.

Maximum \$500.00.

6. Bylaw No. 11/99 is hereby repealed.
